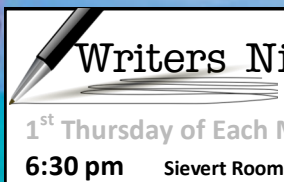

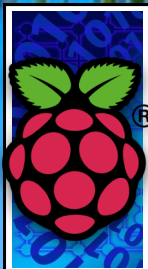

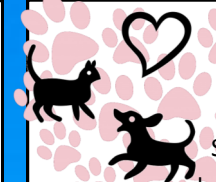


## Waddlers & Walkers

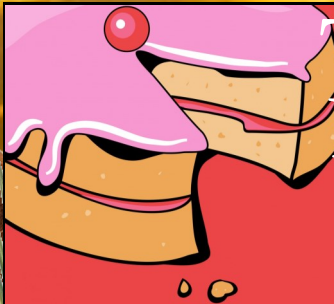
