
FPL TAB Franklin Public Library Teen Advisory Board

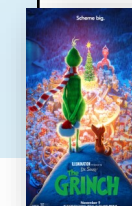

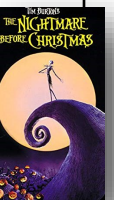
