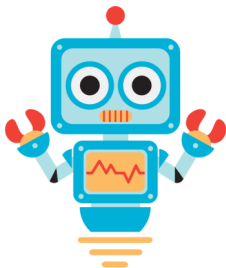

Mo Willems Week

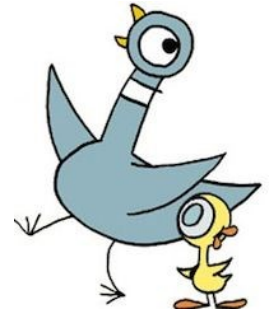
