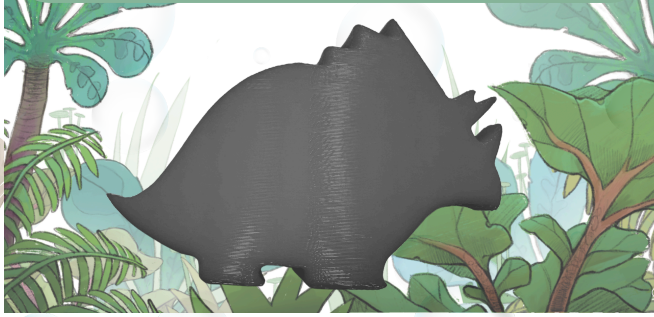

AN EVENING WITH BEN FRANKLIN

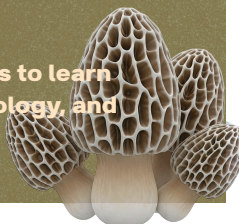
TUESDAY, JUNE 16 @ 6:30PM
