Side-by-side, dark and light will fight the knowledge-based battle for truth, valor, and distinction. To all those brave enough to take the on the noble challenge: may the force be with you.

Doors for the event open at 7pm and the battle commences at 7:30pm with a live orchestra rendition of the Star Wars theme song. Complimentary themed desserts and appetizers will be served all night to fuel the fighters' stamina, and alcoholic beverages will be available for purchase for those over 21. To get up to ludicrous speed, "Spaceballs," followed by a "LEGO Star Wars" movie will be showing in the background. Costumes and geekwear are highly encouraged. Should you need a costume, you can create Yoda ears in the library's storytime room swamp.

So long as peace can be maintained, dark and light can fight together in teams of up to 6 players. First, second, and third place prizes will awarded to the highest performing teams; and those with the best team costume will be bestowed the honor of destroying the library's Death Star piñata.

Tickets are \$20 in advance and \$25 at the door. They can be purchased in person or over the phone. All proceeds of the event will go towards expanding the library's CreateSpace with new, innovative technology like virtual reality systems and laser cutters.
