FRANKLIN, WI – Winter is the perfect time for making hot chocolate, putting on the fireplace, and snuggling in with a good book. Why not earn prizes at the same time? Franklin Public Library's annual Teen and Adult Winter Reading Programs start January 3 and run until February 28.

Adult and teen (grades 7-12) readers can pick up a reading log at the library anytime on or after January 3 and begin claiming prizes or prize entry slips January 9. A prize will be given for the first logged book, and a prize entry slip will be given for every subsequent logged book. All reading logs must be turned in by 8:30pm January 28 to receive prizes.

In addition to the reading logs, three special teen programs will run during the Winter Reading Program for teen participants.

Saturday, February 11, 2-4pm: Valentine Videogame Showdown – Compete at MarioKart, Super Smash Bothers, and more while enjoying sweet treats. Registration is not required.

Friday, February 24, 2-4pm: Delicious Donuts – Create your own crazy donut flavors and toppings! Registration is required.
